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GÜLOR ÖKÜZGÖZÜ MALBEC 2014

Tasting Notes

Deep ruby colour. Fresh aromas of red fruits, wild strawberry. It has pleasant round tannins on the palate. This young wine is suitable to drink now also can be aged.

Winery

Founded by the businesswoman and philanthropist Güler Sabancı in 1993, Gulor has been crafting fine wines in Thrace. Gulor's modern winery and estate vineyards are located in Sarkoy, the historical centre of wine production of the region. Gulor has been awarded prestigious awards internationally for fine wines crafted with local and international grape varieties.

Vinification

After hand harvesting, the grapes were de-stemmed and crushed. Maceration lasted for 3 weeks. Alcoholic fermentation processed between 15 to 17 degrees. Remained in stainless steel vats for 16 months and aged for 4 months in bottle prior to release.
