Tasting Notes

Clear, medium ruby in colour with purple hints. On the nose, the wine has fresh vibrant aromas of ripe blackberries, black cherries with subtle vanilla and nutty nuances. This full bodied Barbera d'Asti has a touch of apricot and an elegant finish.

Producer

The story of Cascina Roera started in 2002 when two friends joined forces. Claudio Rosso and Piero Nebiolo produce their wines in a 8 ha in Costigliole d'Asti. Their approach to wine production is integralist. " We grow our grapes in respect and harmony of the nature and terroir" says Claudio.

Vinification

The grapes were hand harvested in small chests between 10th and 20th September. After soft crushing and skin contact of 60 to 70 days the wine remained in oak barrels for one year and one year in cement tank. San Martino was released after 18 to 24 months in bottle.
